Jacks or Better – game rules

Jacks or Better is a video poker game based upon standard poker conventions and how hands are dealt and created. The game features regular poker hands and the special hands, 'Jacks or Better' which are pairs of Jacks, Queens, Kings or Aces.

Return To Player (RTP): 99.54%

GAME RULES

- The game is played with a minimum of 5 hands and different bet levels
- The number of hands can be 5, 10, 25, 50 or 100 and is set using the HANDS selector
- The bet level is set using the BET LEVEL selector
- Each hand is played with a 52-card deck which is reshuffled for each hand
- Each hand is played with a separate deck
- A new deck is used after each game
- The player is given 5 cards and has the opportunity to discard one or more of them in exchange for new ones drawn from the same virtual deck
- The player may discard all 5 of their original cards if they so choose
- Winning combinations and payouts are made according to the Paytable
- Simultaneous wins on different hands are added
- Only the highest winning combination is paid for each hand
- Play begins by selecting the DEAL button
- To select cards to hold, press/click on the cards
- The text HELD will appear over the cards that you have selected
- The cards selected will be held for every hand that is being played
- Once you have chosen the cards to hold, click the DEAL button to deal the second hand
- After the final cards are dealt, all types of hand wins are displayed in a table on the game screen
- Additionally, winning hands are highlighted on the game screen







GAME FEATURES

Winning hands

- The special 'Jacks or Better' (Two Jacks, Queens, Kings or Aces)
- All the other hand combinations in video poker are the same as in table poker:
 - o Two pair
 - o Three of a kind
 - o Straight (a sequence of 5 cards of consecutive value)
 - o Flush (any 5 cards of the same suit)
 - o Full house (a pair and a three of a kind)
 - o Four of a kind (four cards of the same value)
 - o Straight flush (5 consecutive cards of the same suit)
 - o Royal flush (a Ten, a Jack, a Queen, a King and an Ace of the same suit)

GAME FUNCTIONS

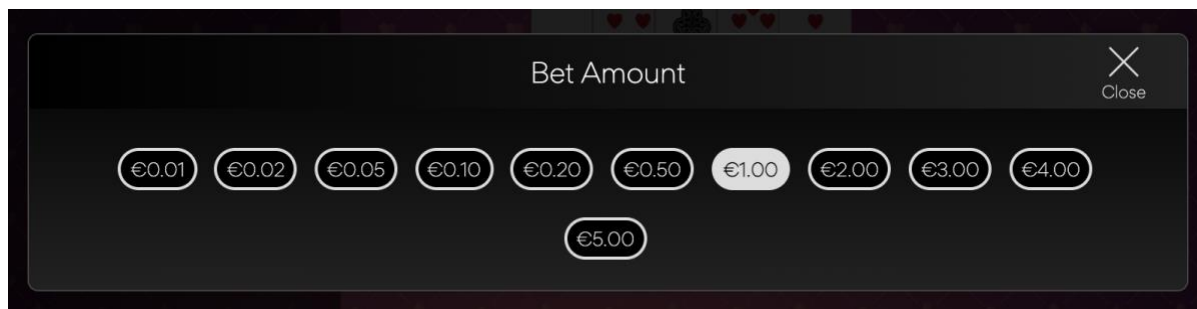
Jacks or Better – game rules

	<p>DEAL BUTTON (INITIAL DEAL)</p> <p>Click to start a game round at the current bet value and number of hands.</p>
	<p>DEAL BUTTON (COMPLETE BET)</p> <p>Click to complete the game round after holding 0 to 5 of the initial cards.</p>
	<p>HANDS SELECTION</p> <p>Click to change the number of hands. The number displays how many hands will be played.</p>
	<p>BET AMOUNT BUTTON</p> <p>Click to open the bet amount pop-up menu. The number displays the current bet/hand.</p>
	<p>MENU BUTTON</p> <p>Click to open the settings, payable and game rules.</p>
	<p>AUDIO BUTTON</p> <p>Click to toggle all audio on/off.</p>

POP-UP MENUS

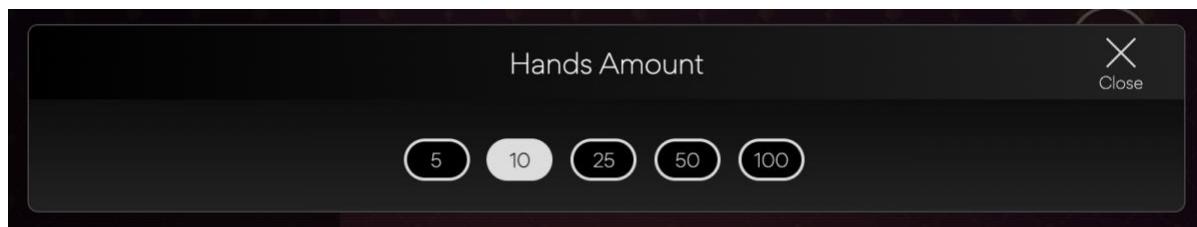
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Bet Amount



The bet amount pop-up menu displays all available bet/hand options. The currently selected amount is highlighted white. The player can also click on the 'Back' icon, to return to the main game screen without making any changes to the bet amount.

Hands selection



The hands selection pop-up menu displays all available hand options (5, 10, 25, 50 or 100). The currently selected number is highlighted white. The player can also click on the 'Back' icon, to return to the main game screen without making any changes to the number of hands.

GAME SETTINGS AND REGULATORY

Current time

The game client shows the current time at all times (in the bottom left of the screen). The time is acquired from the player's computer or device system clock.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The time after which inactive game sessions are automatically ended.
